




We only work in countries where we can be of **added value**.



When Northern Bangladesh was hit by huge floods, **5** local radio stations continuously broadcast for 23 hours to inform and save the lives of millions of people in the affected areas.

Just some time before, all 18 Bangladeshi community radio stations were trained in fast and adequate reporting during disasters.

24.000.000 Russian-speaking readers in 7 countries: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova, Ukraine and Russia.

Radio Dabanga

Radio Dabanga has been the only source of reliable news for and about Darfur and Sudan for years. The radio station also distributes crucial updates via WhatsApp, reaching more than **133,000** people daily.

Dabanga also daily receives about 100 news tip-offs through WhatsApp.
